ART: An art kit and materials for projects may be purchased from school. Estimated cost for each grade is as follows: 8th grade - \$12, 7th grade - \$12 and 6th grade \$4. General needs for all grades include: .05 mechanical pencil, .05 lead refills, colored pencils, scissors, and No. 2 standard pencil.
